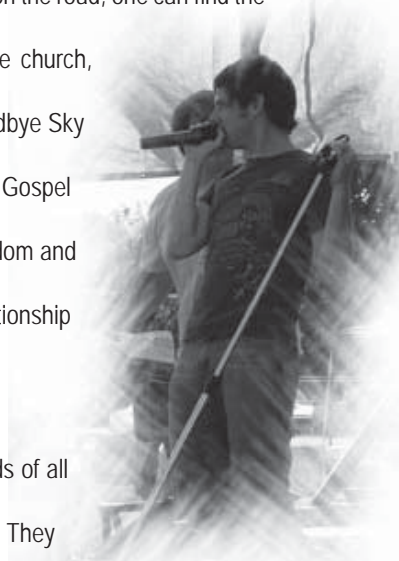




biography

Also in 2006, the band was selected to join EXTREME TOUR, the largest Indie band tour in the nation.
